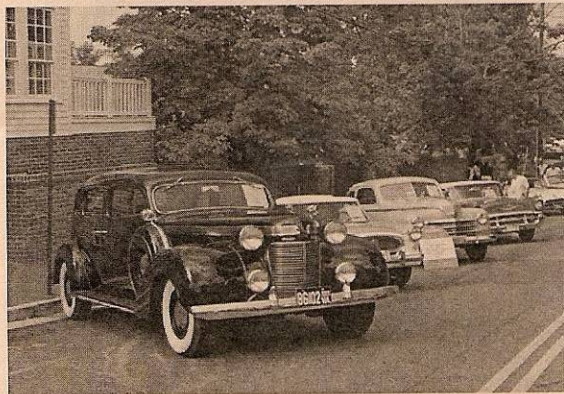

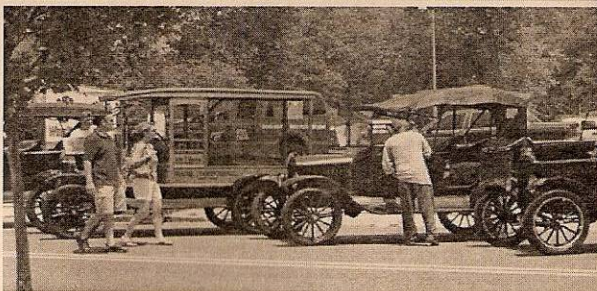

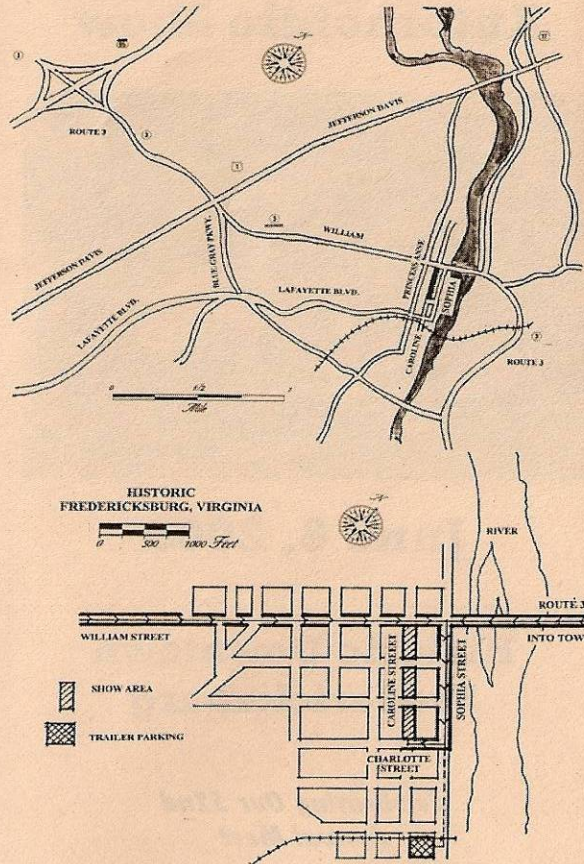


### Directions Into Old Town from the West

From I-95 take exit 130 to Route 3 East toward Fredericksburg. Stay in the left lane and follow signs to downtown Fredericksburg. Turn left on business Route 3/William Street into downtown. Turn right onto Sophia Street. Go three blocks and turn right onto Charlotte Street. Proceed one block to Fredericksburg visitor's center at Caroline Street and show area.

### Directions Into Old Town from the East

Heading West on Route 3 continue straight onto Business Route 3 West and follow till it crosses over the Rappahannock River on the Chatham Bridge into downtown Fredericksburg. Turn immediate left onto Sophia Street and go three blocks and turn right onto Charlotte Street. Proceed one block to Fredericksburg visitor's center at Caroline Street and show area.
