- Cutoff date for pre-registered vehicles is June 17, 2009.
- Fee: Pre-registered \$10.00; at the gate \$15.00.
- Car Corral: Pre-registered \$30.00; at the gate \$45.00 Flea Market Spaces: Pre-registered \$30, at gate \$45
- Trophies awarded at 3:00 p.m. Winners are responsible for picking up their own trophies. No trophies will be mailed.
