Antique Car Show

Celebrate summer, vintage vehicles, and Elvis Presley at this special car show on the beautiful grounds of the Museum of the Shenandoah Valley (MSV) in Winchester, Virginia. Coordinated by the Shenandoah Region of the Antique Automobile Club of America (SRAACA), this car show will be a highlight of the July 17 Glen Burnie Gardens Day event celebrating the Museum's fifth anniversary. On this special day, the exhibition *Elvis at 21: Photographs by Alfred Wertheimer* will be on view in the MSV and the Museum's spectacular Glen Burnie Gardens will be open for free. The car show will take place on the lawn between the Museum and the gardens.



There is no fee for registration; however, registration by July 1 is required. Early registration is encouraged as space is limited to 75 vehicles. All those who show a vehicle will receive free Museum admission (for two) and may win one of several fabulous prizes. Awards will be given for the Oldest Car, Best 1956 Car, and the Museum Director's Choice. Winners in each category will receive a plaque, a copy of the exhibition's companion book, *Elvis at 21: Photographs by Alfred Wertheimer*, and a \$25 Museum Store gift certificate. All registrants will receive a commemorative dash plaque. Food will be available. Trailer parking will be offered at James Wood Middle School (less than one mile from the Museum.)

The Museum of the Shenandoah Valley complex includes the Glen Burnie Historic House, six acres of spectacular gardens, and a 50,000-square-foot Museum. The Museum includes eleven gallery rooms, a store, and café. On view in the MSV Changing Exhibition Gallery from July 10 through October 10, *Elvis at 21* was developed collaboratively by the Smithsonian's National Portrait Gallery, the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service, and Govinda Gallery, and it is sponsored nationally by History™. 92.5 WINC FM is a sponsor of the exhibition's display at the MSV.

The Museum is located at 901 Amherst Street, Winchester, VA 22601.

From points north: Take Interstate 81 south to Exit 317. Follow signs for Route 37 south. Travel south on Route 37 to Route 50. Turn left onto Route 50/Amherst Street. After approximately one mile, the entrance is on the right.

From points south: Take Interstate 81 north to Exit 310. Follow signs for Route 37 north. Travel north on Route 37 to Route 50. Turn right onto Route 50/Amherst Street. After approximately one mile, the entrance is on the right.
