Assemble and Departure Location: Parking Lot of Longhorn Restaurant in Chantilly, VA, just east of US Rte 50 at Rte 28 (north side). Enter from Centerview Drive.

Directions to Stop #1: Tarara Winery, Leesburg, VA

Begin from parking lot and head west on US Rte 50 for about 13 miles to intersection with Rte 15 (Gilbert's Corner). Turn right on Rte 15 (north) and continue for about 11 miles. Continue straight through the town of Leesburg, South & North King Streets, to merge with Rte 15 Leesburg By-Pass on north end. Continue on Rte 15 for about 10 miles to the Village of Lucketts. Turn right onto Rte 662, Lucketts Road, and continue for 3 miles to Tarara Winery, entrance on the left. At the split, take road to left, up small hill to picnic area at top on left. A winery employee will direct you to a parking area. **Location: Tarara Winery, 13648 Tarara Lane, Leesburg, VA 20176 (703) 771-7100**

Stop #1: Tarara Winery, Leesburg, VA

The winery is magnificently situated on 475-acres, on the bluffs of the Potomac River. Tarara offers a special elegant setting. It has versatile spaces designed to compliment the beautiful surrounding nature. Our visit is timed to coincide with the winery's Annual Spring Barrel Tasting Festival.



Tarara VIP Private Tasting & Tour (A Wine Lovers Delight) - special presentation of award-winning Tarara Wines. A Tarara wine specialist will present a tasting of award-winning wines in our reserved picnic area. With the VIP Private Tour and Tasting, your select wines will be accompanied by light hors d'oeuvres paired to enhance your experience and your palette. Bring your own picnic lunch and other drinks to fully satisfy your luncheon needs. Your wine specialist will discuss the different types of wines and make recommendations for food pairing with wine and other help to assist you in choosing the right wine to please your guests at home. Following your private tasting, your party will be personally guided through a tour of the Winemakers' 6,000 square foot cave where you will learn about the winemaking techniques used in producing Tarara wines. You will be able to participate in the Annual Spring Barrel Tasting Festival of sample wines celebrating the release of new vintages.

Directions to Stop #2: Home of Jack & Mildred Hardman, Great Falls, VA

Leaving the winery, turn right on Rte 662 and continue to Rte 15 in Lucketts. Turn left onto Rte 15 (south). Continue south on Rte 15, bear left into Rte 15 By-pass and continue to south side of Leesburg and right ramp to merge with Rte 7 south towards Tyson's Corner (about 24 miles total). Continue on Rte 7 to intersection with Rte 193, Georgetown Pike. Turn left onto Rte 193 (east) and follow for approximately 3 miles to Village of Great Falls. Continue past lighted intersection (Walker Road) to 1st road on left, Innsbruck Avenue. Turn left, continue for about 1.5 miles bearing right at curve and straight at 3 way split. Note sign on left with 548 on it. Park in circular driveway or just past it to parking apron in front of garage. **Location: Jack & Mildred Hardman home, 548 Innsbruck Avenue, Great Falls, VA 22066 (703) 759-5281**

Distance to Stop #2: 28 miles
Travel Time to Stop #2: About 38 minutes
