




Annual Fall Car Show: Professional Pride

The theme for this year's Annual Fall Car Show at Capitol Cadillac will be *Professional Pride*, celebrating the long and storied history of Cadillac and LaSalle professional cars. Specifically, Cadillac and LaSalle ambulances, combinations, flower cars, hearses and limousines from all model years will be the honored cars at the show to be held on Sunday October 28th at Capitol Cadillac in Greenbelt, MD.

Every Cadillac and LaSalle Professional Car owner is encouraged to attend this very special show. To celebrate the event, each registered owner will receive a commemorative dash plaque illustration (pictured above) by renowned artist Dan Reed. Also, each registered owner will be given a commemorative show program highlighting the history of Cadillac and LaSalle Professional Cars and featuring a description of each Professional Car pre-registered for the show. In addition, the Professional Car owners will receive a framed certificate of appreciation for participating. It is time for the Professional Cars to take their place alongside the V-12 / V-16 Cadillacs, Eldorados, LaSalles, Fleetwoods, Capitol Cadillac Alumni Cars, and DeVilles that have been featured at the Potomac Region's past six theme-related fall car shows.

The judging will be done by the owners of the vehicles registered. The registered owners will be able to judge cars in all classes, including their own, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given to winning vehicles in each class, **including three special classes for the Professional Cars.**

Capitol Cadillac is an easy five minute drive from the Holiday Inn Greenbelt where rooms will be reserved for Friday thru Sunday at the special rate of **\$94/night** (301-982-7000 – mention "Cadillac & LaSalle Club" when making reservation). The Holiday Inn Greenbelt will also be the site for a dinner the night before the show hosted by past CLC President Richard Sills & Shelley Chadick. LOCAL DIRECTIONS:

From Capital Beltway (1-495/95)

- Use Exit 23 Kenilworth Avenue Rte 201, proceed South on Kenilworth Avenue to first exit -Greenbelt Road, Route 193
- At light, proceed East on Greenbelt Road - Rte 193 (left)
- At traffic light make left onto Walker Drive (*TGI Friday's* Restaurant on corner)
- Make an immediate right onto Capitol Drive (Dealership is on the left)

<u>From Baltimore-</u> <u>Washington Parkway</u> (<u>Rte 295)</u>

- Use Exit for Rte 193
 (Greenbelt Road)
- Proceed West on Rte 193
 Greenbelt Road
- Make first right after underpass onto Capitol Drive (Dealership is on your right)

Car Show Rules

- **Rain or Shine**: The car show will take place rain or shine. No refunds.
- <u>Safety</u>: If a vehicle has fluid drips or leaks, the owner must bring absorbent material or drip pans to avoid slippery conditions and to protect the showroom floor or show field parking lot. The Potomac Region reserves the right to prevent any cars with excessive fluid leaks from entering the show field. It is recommended that a working fire extinguisher be in every vehicle.
- Judging / Parking Rules: The Potomac Region reserves the right (1) to determine each vehicle's judging class and (2) each vehicle's placement in the show field. There will be no parking on the grassy areas whatsoever, due to sprinkler heads and possible rut damage. Vehicles will be peer judged by the individual owners of the registered cars. Registrants will be able to judge vehicles in all classes, including their own. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given to winning vehicles in each class.
