DIRECTOR'S REMARKS: Dan Ruby thanked everyone for attending the meeting. Best wishes to Maurice Jones, as his son, Terrence, recovers from injuries sustained in a recent motorcycle accident. Congratulations to Scot Minesinger & Mercedes Campos, who were recently married in Puerto Rico. Special welcome to new member Jim Dillard who attended his first meeting.

SECRETARY'S REMARKS: The minutes from the previous meeting were not reviewed since they were published and distributed to all members in the December 2022 newsletter.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Bill Hilliard reported there was a net profit of \$2,039.75 from Fiscal Year 2022. A large portion of that amount was used to subsidize the Annual Holiday Party held in February. As a result, the financials from the beginning of the calendar year to the present show a new loss of (\$1,284.41), based on total revenue of \$1,662.56 and total expense of \$2,946.97. In addition to the member subsidy for the Annual Holiday Party, a charitable donation made to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society is reflected in the total expense total above.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT: Franklin Gage announced that we have 159 members currently for 2023. 

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.



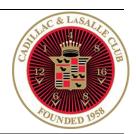

Car Show Rules

- <u>Rain Date</u>: Sunday, May 21, 2023, is the rain date for this show. If inclement weather causes a postponement or cancellation, an email will be sent to all pre-registered attendees (email address required on registration form) and Potomac Region members. In addition, an announcement will be posted on the club's website. Rules of participation will be subject to any COVID-related restrictions by the county or dealership, if any, in effect on the show date.
- <u>Safety</u>: If a vehicle has fluid drips or leaks, the owner must bring absorbent material or drip pans to avoid slippery conditions and to protect the show field parking lot. The Potomac Region reserves the right to prevent any cars with excessive fluid leaks from entering the show field. It is recommended that a working fire extinguisher be in every vehicle.
- <u>Judging / Parking Rules</u>: The Potomac Region reserves the right 1) to determine each vehicle's judging class and 2) placement in the show field. Vehicles will be peer judged by the individual owners of the registered cars, including their own. Awards will be given to winning vehicles in each class. Trailer parking is available.
- Food and Drink: A food vendor will be on-site. All participants and guests are responsible for their own food and beverages.
- **Chairs:** All participants and guests are responsible for bringing their own chairs.



CADILLAC NOVELS BY STEPHEN CLARK


Here is another review of the Cadillac-related books I have read recently.





Must have coffee-table book for any Cadillac or car collector. 128-color-filled pages with Cadillac advertisements, facts, and pictures of exterior and interior views from the 1912 Model Thirty to the 1978 Seville. The Cadillac ads in themselves make this book spectacular. *****



<u>Cadillac 1948-1964 Photo Album</u> edited by Mark A. Patrick. Published in 1998. Contains 110 pages filled with black and white photographs from the Detroit Public Library's National Automotive History Collection.
